Another great success has been our Secret Santa Shop, which raised £323.64 in just four days.

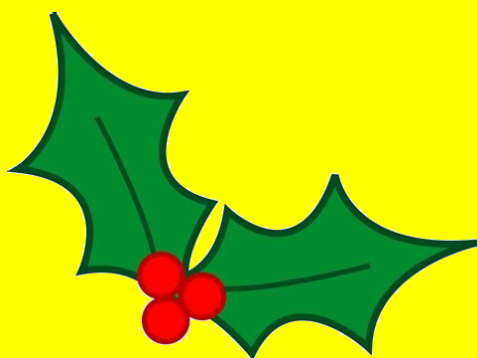
