Parking at School

Parking on Casaedona and Church Road is continuing to be difficult for our school families and local residents alike. There have been a number of 'near-misses' involving children and cars, and the police have again been informed of the situation.

In order to reduce congestion near the lane on Church Road, we are now opening additional gates further up the site.

- Young children should be escorted across roads. Please take care when crossing a road from between parked cars.
- Please ensure that you do not park on or too close to corners. The legal distance for parking is 15 metres from a corner. Visibility at both entrances can be difficult at times.
- Please take special care when reversing. Small children are hard to see through rear-view mirrors.
- Please make sure that you leave enough footpath for pedestrians to pass safely.
- Please make sure that vehicles can pass on the road and remember that lorries and vans need to be able to access the roads as well as cars.
- Please respect residents by not parking over driveways and access lanes or making it difficult for them to enter or leave their premises.

We appreciate your continuing support to keep our whole school community safe and develop good relations with our neighbours.
